
# Assembling Directions Materials Needed:








- 1. Using your edited <u>First Draft</u>, complete the <u>writing</u> sections in your Wanted Poster templates. <u>Draw and colour a picture</u> of the character in the PHOTOGRAPH box.
- 2. Be sure to follow the steps below and <u>do not cut along the primary black borders</u> until the final step. This will help to ensure that the left, right, top and bottom margins are even.
- 3. <u>Cut</u> off the <u>top</u> dotted line on the NOVEL DESCRIPTION/NOVEL SUMMARY template. <u>Glue</u> this template on top of the PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION/LAST SEEN template.
- 4. <u>Cut</u> off the <u>left</u> dotted lines on the PHOTOGRAPH template. <u>Glue</u> this template on top of the PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION/LAST SEEN template.

5. <u>Cut</u> off the <u>top and left</u> dotted lines on the WANTED FOR template. <u>Glue</u> this final template on top of the other three templates, making sure that all of the borders meet evenly.

- 6. <u>Cut</u> out the <u>WANTED</u> text box. Write your character's name in this box and glue it at the top of your Wanted Poster between the two thumb tacks.
- 7. <u>Cut</u> out the <u>REWARD AMOUNT</u> text box and glue it in the middle of your Wanted Poster (above NOVEL DESCRIPTION and WANTED FOR).
- 8. Now, <u>cut out your Wanted Poster</u> along the left, right, top and bottom black margins. <u>Colour</u> all of the sections of your Wanted Poster.
- 9. Turn the Wanted Poster over and secure all the sections with <u>tape</u>, so that they will not come apart.
