Assembling Directions



Materials Needed:

<input type="radio"/> First Draft	<input type="radio"/> Pencil or Pen
<input type="radio"/> Final Draft Templates	<input type="radio"/> Color Pencils/Markers
<input type="radio"/> Evaluation Rubric	<input type="radio"/> Scissors, Glue, and Tape



1. Using your edited First Draft, complete the writing sections in your dog templates.
2. Cut out all the pieces along the solid and dotted black lines.
3. Glue the head on top of the dog's body (make sure that you do not cover the writing section in the dog's body.)
4. Glue the legs behind the dog's body (near the top section where the body gets wider.) Be sure that no white parts are showing.
5. Glue the tail behind dog's body, at the top, and in the middle.
6. Glue the bowl just on top of the two front paws. Try to cover the least amount of space as possible, so that you can see the majority of the front paws.
7. Draw a picture in the dog's bowl and color all of the sections of your dog templates.
8. Now, turn the dog over and tape these sections together securely, so that they will not fall apart.
