


# President's Day Project

Due February 12, 2019

Students need to create a poster board project about a president. The poster board should include the following items.

Title	The title is clear and not too big that it takes over the board	1	2	3	4	5
Map	Should show where your president was born/buried Remember to label the city and state.	1	2	3	4	5
Seal	The Presidential seal is mounted on the poster board.	1	2	3	4	5
Pictures	Pictures are clear and mounted with a frame.	1	2	3	4	5
Timeline	Six events - A schedule of events in chronological order Example: 	1	2	3	4	5
Written Report	Include information about your president using your own words in complete sentences and paragraph form. Do not use words that are not part of your vocabulary.	1	2	3	4	5
Oral Report	Share your project with the class using notecards - you know your information and show evidence that you have practiced at home.	1	2	3	4	5

- A title which is the president's name.
- A map showing where their president was born/buried
- A timeline, which should include six, but no more than ten, events from their president's life.

Examples- a short description of facts should be given for each date

- ✓ Birth
- ✓ Education
- ✓ Marriage
- ✓ Children
- ✓ Political offices held
- ✓ Important event that occurred during their president's time in office
- ✓ Death

❖ Remember, these must be in your own words and not a printed copy from the computer or an Encyclopedia.

- Mount pictures on colored construction paper.
- An idea to add - the slogan of the president's election.
- Written form must be completed and placed on your poster board or you may type it.
- Oral Report - Students will share their project with the class and on Grandparent's Day.

This project should be fun and educational. Please BE NEAT, cut your pictures neat and straight, color within the lines, and mount your pictures and maps on the poster board. These posters will be on display in the mall.
